Be a good Neighbor!

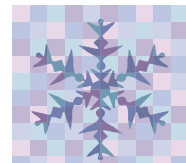
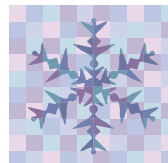
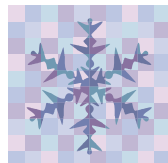
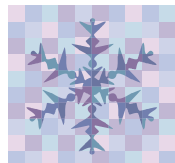
