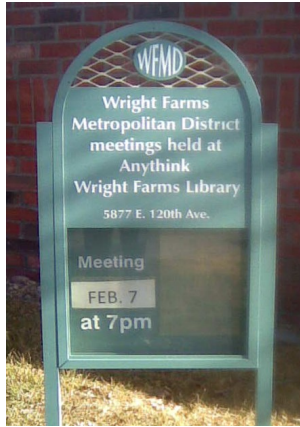
Announcing...

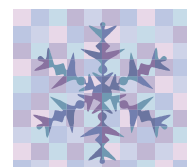
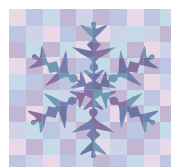
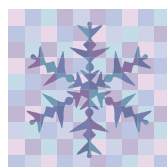
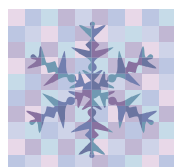
**Be a good Neighbor!**
