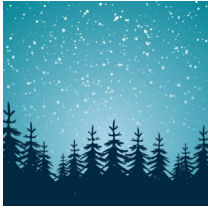

Be Safe!

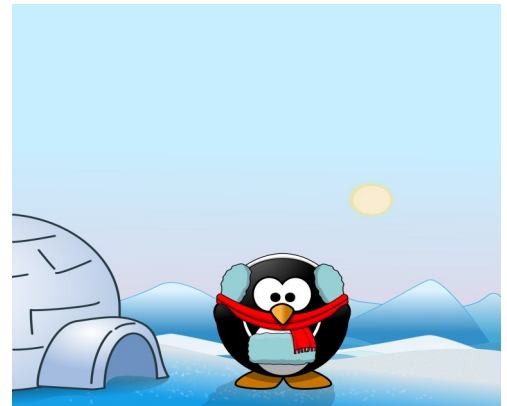

Also, be courteous regarding your **barking dogs.** It can be cited as a noise violation after 10 pm or before 6 am. If the dog barks for longer than 10 minutes during the day, you could be visited by animal control. After a warning, it could mean a sizable fine.

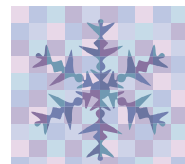
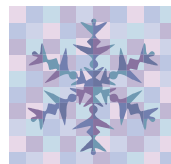
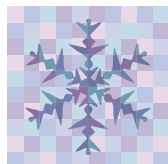
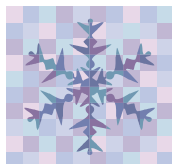
